# **BOARD EXAM RESULTS**

The outstanding children of Mary Mount achieved a 100% resounding success in the CBSE Class XII and Xth Board exams

A total of 18 student secured A1 for all subjects, 22 students secured A1 for 4 subjects and 45 students secured 90% and above overall. Krishna Satheesh and Irene Joshy secured full marks for Board mathematics paper.
